Arrests Made in Series of Burglaries Crossing Three Counties

The Hanover, Goochland, and Louisa County Sheriff's Offices recently coordinated their efforts in the investigation of a series of residential burglaries occurring in late 2009. As a result of these efforts, **Erving E. Stewardson**, a 38 year old white male from the 2300 block of Davis Hwy in Louisa, and **Montel D. Terry**, a 25 year old black male from the 2700 block of Lanudal Drive in Richmond, have been arrested and charged with multiple counts of burglary and grand larceny. Both Stewardson and Terry are currently incarcerated at the Pamunkey Regional Jail.

Stewardson and Terry have been linked to three cases in Hanover County, three cases in Goochland County, and as many as six in Louisa County. Currently, charges have been obtained in the cases in Hanover and Goochland Counties. The charges in Louisa County are pending. Investigators have recovered some property and are continuing to work diligently to recover additional property and potentially link these two individuals with additional crimes.

The collective efforts of the Deputies and Investigators in each of the localities contributed extensively to the apprehension of these two individuals.
