### **Section D – Equipment**

**Item – Law Enforcement Thermal Imaging Camera: \$ 11,650 per unit x 1 unit = \$11,650.00**

This item will be kept readily available for investigators and responding deputies to be used for two primary purposes:

- 1) to aid in the search for lost or missing persons in wooded areas and at night, and
- 2) to look for evidence at crime scenes. (The unit is sensitive enough to detect heat differentials for up to two or more hours. The unit will aid deputies in the recovery of evidence that has been hidden or tossed from a vehicle. It will also help to locate spent shell casings from firearms.)

**Item – Law Enforcement Digital Imaging Camera w/kit: \$15,075 per unit x 1 unit = \$15,075**

The Sheriff's Office Rescue Team (Tactical Operations) will use this unit. In addition to the uses listed above, the kit includes an extra battery and hand held viewer which may receive remote transmissions from the camera. This will allow greater safety for team members searching for armed suspects in tactical situations and will give commanders a real time view of the search from the command post.

**Item – Universal Forensic Extraction Device for portable media: \$4,686 per unit x 1unit = \$4,686.00**

This unit will give investigators the ability to extract evidentiary data from portable media devices (cell phones, PDA, etc). This will prove useful in investigations for missing persons, abductions, runaways, and investigations of predatory internet behavior when portable devices are available and time is of the essence.

**Item – Automatic External Defibrillator: \$2,500 per unit x 5 units = \$12,500.00**

Deputies are often the first to arrive at scenes of cardiac distress. As a result, deputies often provide care to citizens for some time prior to the arrival of emergency medical help. All deputies are trained in the use of CPR and AED's. However there are not enough existing units for every patrol car. These items will ensure that each deputy has ready access to an AED unit to provide cardiac care to the citizens of the county.

**Item- Alco-Sensor Breath Alcohol Meter: \$350 per unit x 5 units = \$1,750.00**

The Sheriff's Office aggressively seeks to deter drunken and impaired drivers. We also enforce underage drinking statues. These units will aid deputies in determining probable cause for DUI. In addition, they will be used to identify underage drinking and the subsequent return of impaired juveniles to parents or guardians.
