The Goochland Sheriff's Office grant program is titled "Equipment and Technology for Safety."

The goals of the project are to:

1. Stimulate the U. S. economy using **Recovery Act** funds,
2. Preserve American jobs using **Recovery Act** funds by purchasing items which are manufactured, packaged, transported and sold by American companies, and
3. To increase the safety of the citizens served by this agency, the persons arrested by the agency and the officers of the agency via the use of **Recovery Act** funds.

The items will be issued to members of this agency after the necessary training has been completed. It is anticipated that the items will be purchased no later than 180 days after the receipt of **Recovery Act** grant approval. Once the purchase has been completed, training will be completed, and issuance/installation will take place as soon as possible. The equipment made available through the **Recovery Act** funding will likely be delivered within 60 to 90 days after the orders are placed.
